Site 43 daylight shutdown detail

Description

Brief

Site 43 is a permanent installation rated for nocturnal occupation only. As such, site shutdown procedure must be observed as the crew departs. One crew member is to stay behind after departure and perform final shutdown procedures, as listed:

- · Close all interior viewing shutters (Site 43 features three)
- · Set the life support system to dormancy mode
- · Set the reactor control system to low power mode
- · Lower the antenna boom
- · Ensure the mining rover is stowed in its garage

Your work period has been shifted, and starts four (4) hours before dawn, out of which two (2) are allocated for the fullfilment of this work order. Failure to complete the work order as requested may result in damage to the hab and possible termination.

Sunlight on Mercury is classified as a severe avoidable work hazard; if you are still in the site at dawn, Wysham-Yamano will not be liable for potential injury or death.
